Integrative Diagnostics, Level Two: Neurofascial Process

The Diagnostic - classes 1 and 2 are presented as a combined seminar.

Mapping and NFP are already known assessment tools. You will be trained specifically in this seminar and your diagnostic skills will be conceptualized and effectively improved in order to develop effective, efficient and cost-effective treatment plans for all your patients.

INTDG 101 presents 3 planar Myofascial Mapping (positiv, negativ, still) to locate specific areas of body dysfunction, to differentiate between physical tissue dysfunction and energy-induced pain and disability in the spine (clinical significance), in the extremities, in organs and in the brain / cranium. 1st, 2nd, 3rd Level Myofascial Mapping and clinical implication in order to match the assessed maps will lead to determination of primary dysfunction. You will learn to see, whether your patient is suffering from a local or from a systemic problem. So you will be able to decide, which approach will bring the greatest benefit to your patient in a very time-effective way.

INTDG 201 introduces Neurofascial Process for assessment and treatment of multiple and complex patient care problems. With these skills, diagnostics and treatment of all pain, dysfunction and disability will be possible for you. The class introduces Process Centers, Process Energy, Process Energy Synchronizers and treatment options for 3rd level / sagittal plane positive Myofascial Mapping. You will be able to develop an individual treatment plan, a great self-healing tool, not only for your patients.
